Schild Estate Sparkling Chardonnay Pinot Noir Barossa Valley NV 2019

Creamy beginning to the nose, followed by layers of fresh limes and preserved lemons, a touch of honey, aromas of shortbread biscuits and just a hint of red berry pinot fruit lurking somewhere in the back.

Peter Lehman 'Portrait' Riesling Eden Valley 2020

Aromas of freshly picked limes and lifted florals. The palate showcases a fruit purity with a refreshingly crisp, dry finish.

Geoff Hardy Red Label Sauvignon Blanc Adelaide Hills 2021

Vibrant and intense aromas of passionfruit, elderflower, citrus, white peach and just a hint of fresh herbs.

Zilzie Pinot Noir Clare Valley 2020

Charming red berries with a dash of spice and soft tannins. The wine was matured on French oak to add roundness, maintain freshness, and add complexity

Schild Estate Cabernet Sauvignon Barosa Valley 2018

Aromatically the wine is marked both by lifted primary fruit notes of dark plum and blackcurrant along with more savoury glimpses of graphite pencil lead and cedar wood spice. Flavors of black cherry and chocolate

Beresford Bell Tower Merlot McLaren Vale 2015

A thick sweet round entry, very approachable with dark mulberry and fresh plum fruit flavors.

Riversdale Crux Sparkling 2018

Fermented in the bottle according to traditional French methods, this estate-grown Crux sparkling wine is a blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. The palate is driven by single-vineyard Chardonnay, while Pinot Noir adds richness, depth and an element of creaminess to the palate.

Riversdale Chardonnay 2020

A fresh fruit filled palate with tropical fruits balanced with crisp acidity and finishing with good persistence of flavor. Floral, citrus, and herbal notes with nuances of passionfruit and gooseberry aromas.

Riversdale Sauvignon Blanc 2021

Bright, light green hues yield an aroma of floral, citrus, and herbal notes. A tropical fruit palate is balanced with crisp acidity.

Riversdale Pinot Gris 2020

A lovely fresh crisp taste to the palate which is bursting with fresh Pear and Apple flavors complimented with sweet spices and perfumed floral accents.

Riversdale Pinot Noir 2019

The palate is full of bright cherry and raspberry fruit flavors with a hint of spice and subtle violet notes. Silky tannins and lively acids add balance and structure to the long, juicy finish.



Riversdale Estate is located in the basin of the Coal River Valley, in Southern Tasmania. The second largest wine region in Tasmania and continues to grow each year as a result of the unique growing climates located in the Valley. Riversdale is located in the basin of the valley and is the only vineyard to front Pittwater, which gives temperature averages during the winter and summer months. Do to the climate advantages, it is able to produce nine different varieties with a reputation for Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Syrah and Reisling. Riversdale Estate was purchased in 1980 by Ian Roberts. The first vines were planted in 1991 and are some of the oldest in the region.
